- Everyone can dress in DS awareness colors, yellow and blue, and wear mismatched socks with a suggested donation for \$1.00 to be donated to the <u>Down Syndrome</u> Association of CT

- o Sock Drive socks can be made into sock cupcakes in Lunch Bunches and donated.
- Random acts of kindness Students are recognized at the end of the day for random acts of kindness throughout the day
